I am writing to let you know that we will be running a Place2Be group that will support children who have experienced a loss or bereavement. The aim of the group is to help children build coping strategies and support each other. The activities will help children to express emotions and increase understanding and resilience. Depending on demand, we will run one to two small groups (maximum six children) on Thursday afternoons in the summer term.

If you would like your child to take part in this work then please ask for a letter from your child's teacher or the office and return the slip no later than 5 April 2019. I will get in touch with you to discuss the nature of the loss and how we can best support your child.
