Parents Be Aware of Coin Cell Batteries

We're encouraging parents to know where lithium coin cell batteries are in their homes – in products as well as spare and 'flat' batteries – so they can keep them out of children's reach and keep children safe.



Look around any family home and you'll see many products and gadgets powered by button batteries, particularly 3V lithium coin cell batteries like the CR2025, CR2032 and CR2330. For example, thermometers, fitness trackers, 3D glasses, gaming headsets, remote controls, bathroom scales, car keys, flameless candles, robot bug toys, light-up fidget spinners, musical greeting cards – the list is endless.



Please keep these and other small objects out of the reach of young children; they are real choking hazards and can cause fatal accidents.
