Too Many Children are Late for School Each Day

This week so far, **111 children** have been late for school. This is not acceptable; if your child is late for school, they are missing valuable learning time. If your child is 10 minutes late every day, they are missing 50 minutes of learning each week, which is over 3 hours of learning every month, and 32.5 hours every year (equivalent to a working week's learning lost each year due to being late for school).

Classroom doors open at **8.40am** and learning begins at **8.45am** prompt. It is your responsibility to ensure your child attends on time every day. Please help support us to give your child the best start in their education by **getting to school on time!**
