## Mellers Primary School

Welcome to your schools' Transition - 5 years later pack.

This analysis takes the pupils who were in your school at the time of the Summer Census in 2012, 2013, 2014, and who took GCSEs in Nottingham secondary schools 5 years later in 2017, 2018 and 2019.

Explanatory Note:

**Attainment 8 Score:** This adds together the grades from 8 GCSEs or equivalents. Maths and English are generally double-weighted. A score of 40 indicates an average grade of 4 over all 8 GCSEs. For more details on how this is calculated, please see <https://www.gov.uk/government/publications/progress-8-school-performance-measure>

**Progress 8 Score:** This shows the average grade per GCSE or equivalent above or below the "estimated" score. The "estimated" score equates to how pupils with a similar Key Stage 2 Prior Attainment scored. A score of +0.5 indicates a half a grade per GCSE extra to other pupils with a similar Key Stage 2 Prior Attainment.

**% Achieving English and Maths 9-5 (and 9-4):** This shows the percentage of pupils who attain at least a grade 5 (or grade 4) or above in both GCSE Maths and either English Language/English Literature.

**% Achieving English 9-5 (and 9-4):** This shows the percentage of pupils who attain at least a grade 5 (or grade 4) or above in either English Language or English Literature.

**% EBacc Entry:** This shows the percentage of pupils who have been entered into GCSE or AS English, Maths, combined or three separate sciences, a humanity, and a language GCSE (or AS level).

**% Bacc 9-4:** This shows the percentage of pupils who were entered into the above subjects and attained at a GCSE at grade 4 or above (or an AS level) in all of them.

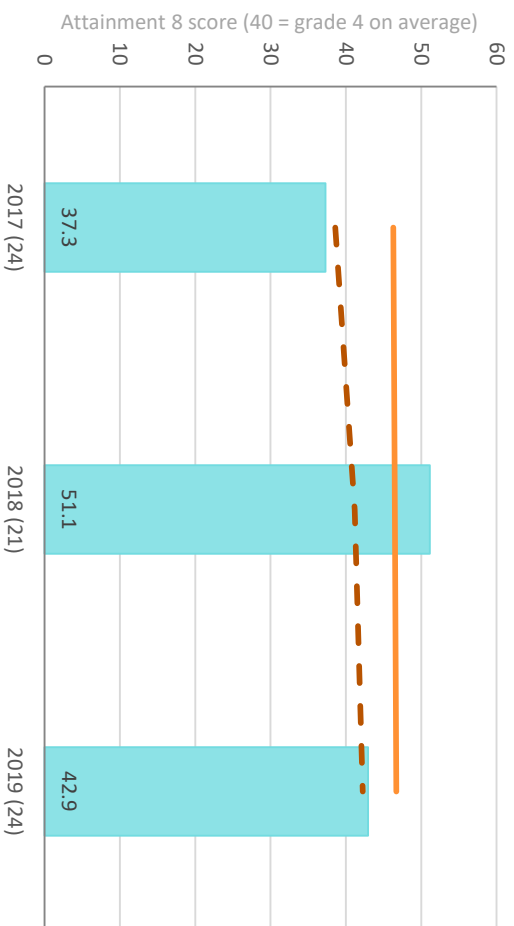
**% Science, Humanities and Languages 9-4:** This shows the percentage of pupils who have both been entered and achieved the requirements for EBacc Science (combined or three separate sciences), EBacc Humanities (Geography or History) or a language GCSE at grade 4 or above (or an AS level).

**% Top Non EBacc subjects taken:** This shows the top non EBacc subjects taken over the last 3 years, and the percentage of your pupils who took them.

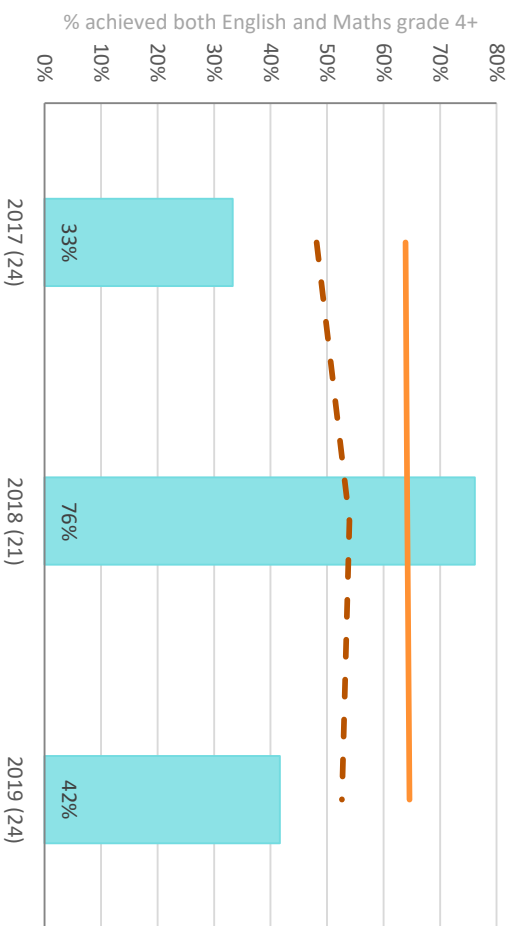
**% Languages taken at GCSE:** This shows the top languages taken at GCSE over the last 3 years.

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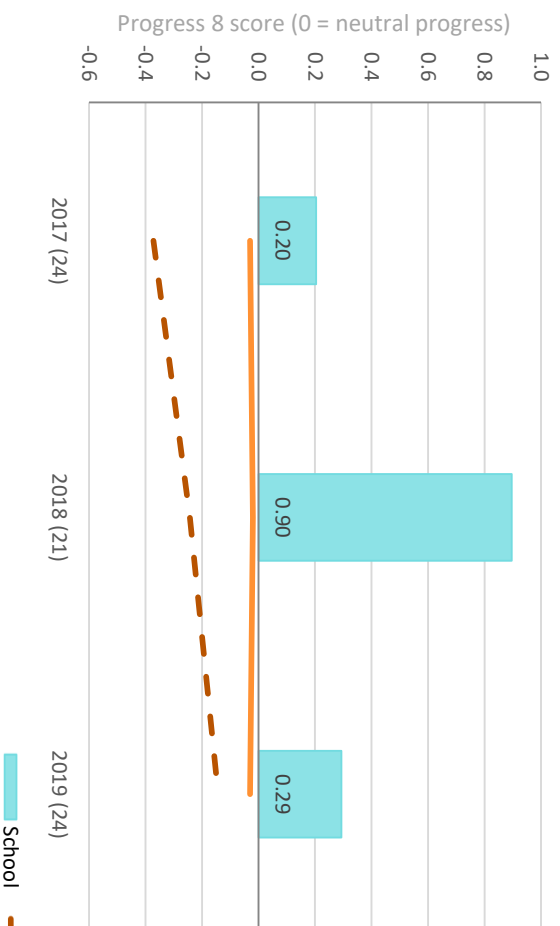
Attainment 8 Score



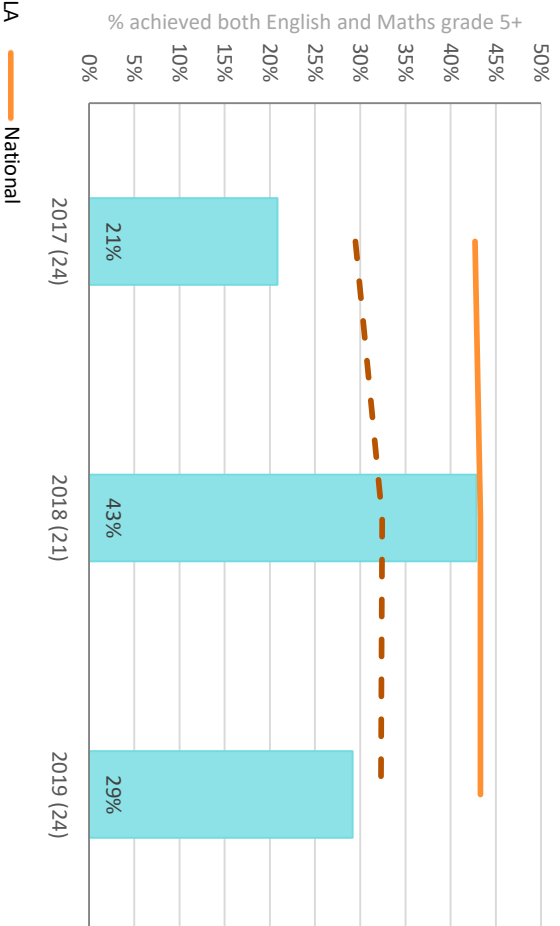
% English and Maths 4+



Progress 8 Score



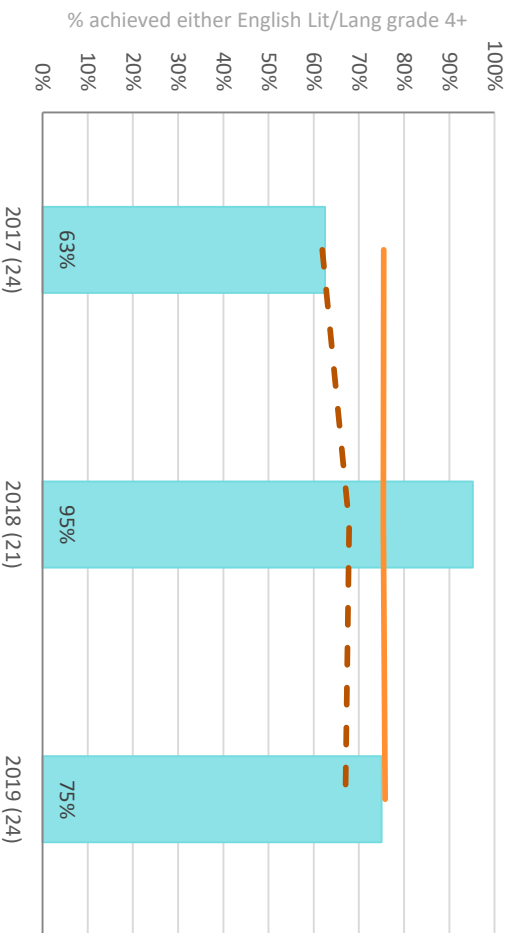
% English and Maths 5+



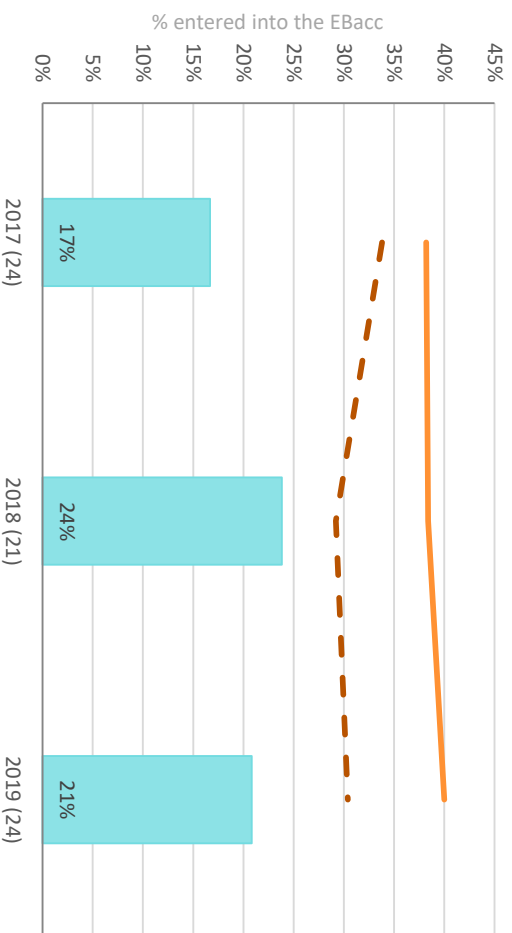
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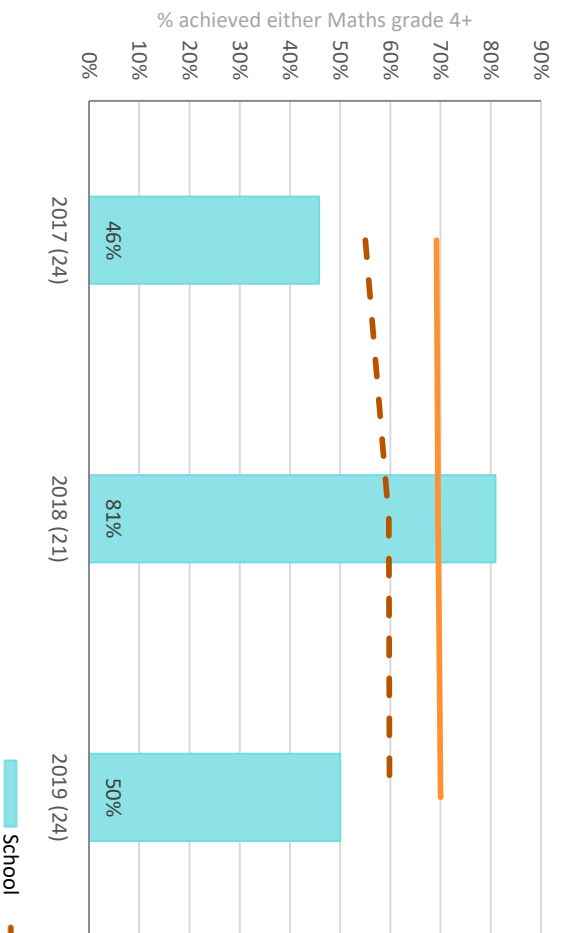

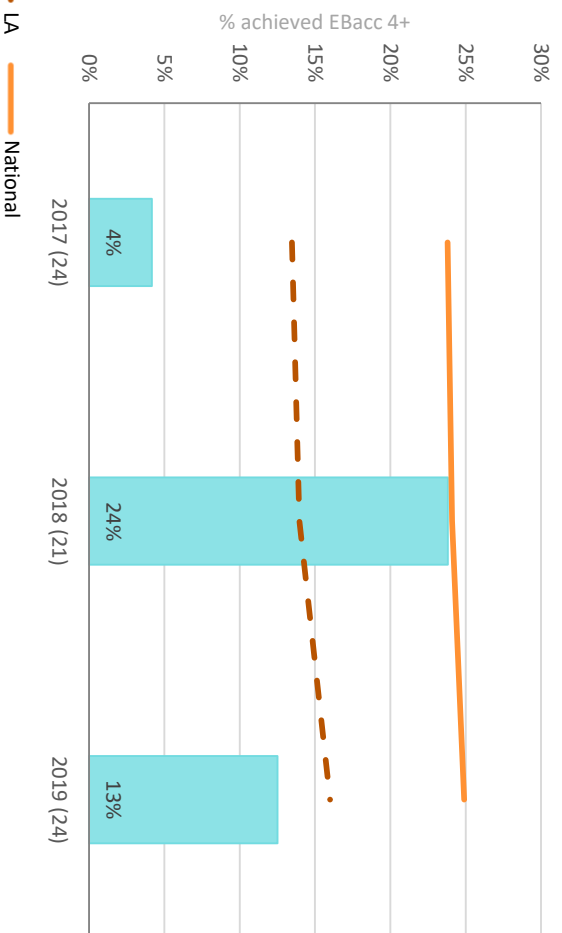

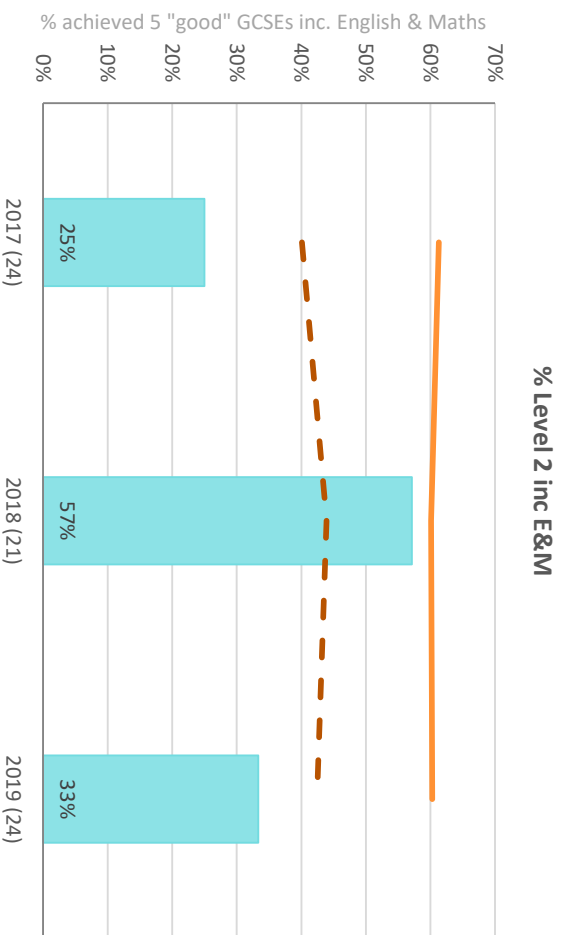

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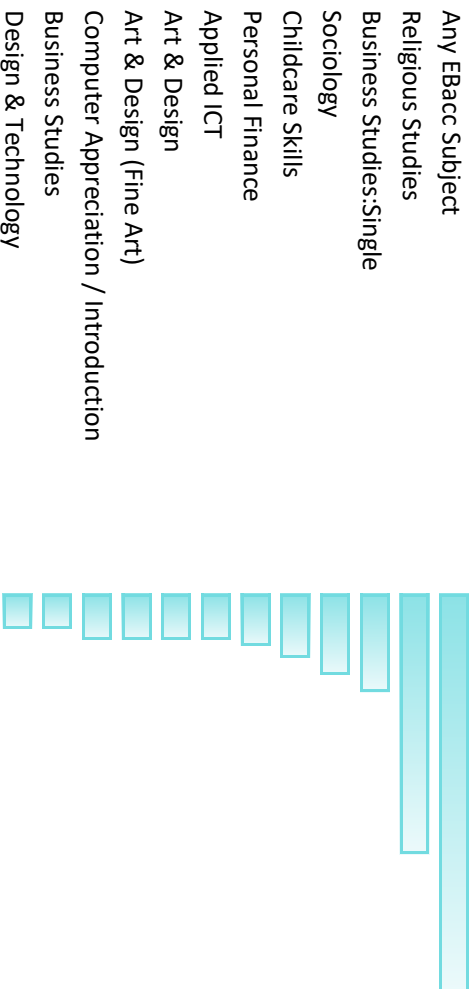
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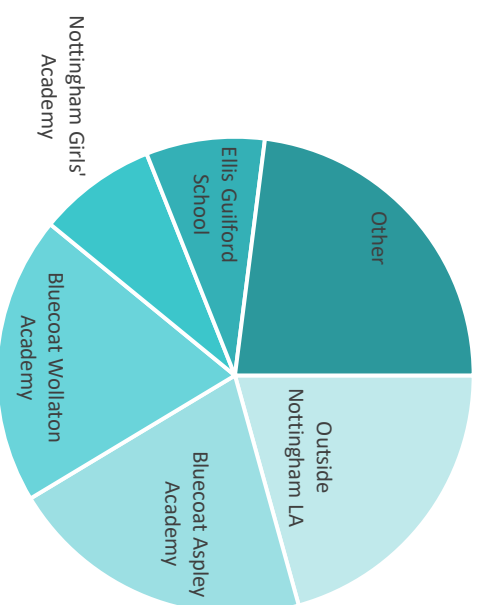

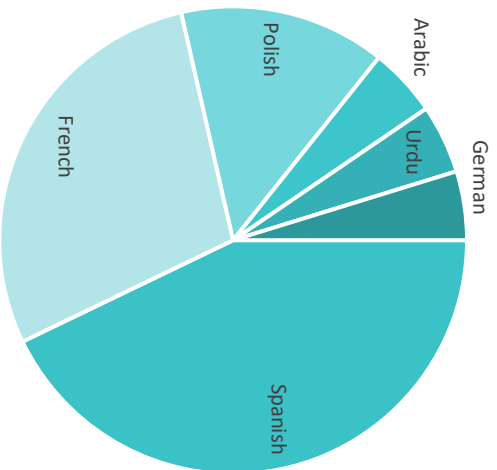
Top Non EBacc subjects taken
