
We know that some of our pupils will need extra help after the COVID lockdown break, so we'll be giving them the support they need so that they don't fall behind any further.


We want to make sure everyone is happy and safe; our supervision system for teachers will be further developed, and our wellbeing teams and school council will carry on supporting staff and children.
