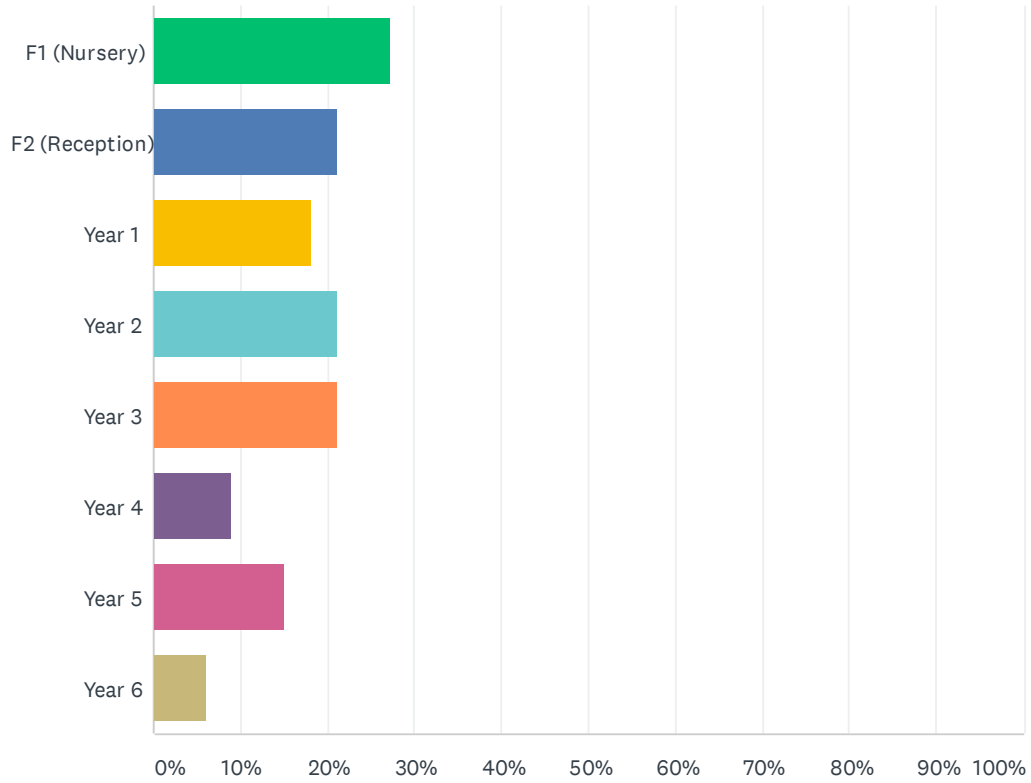


## Q1 Which year group is your child in?

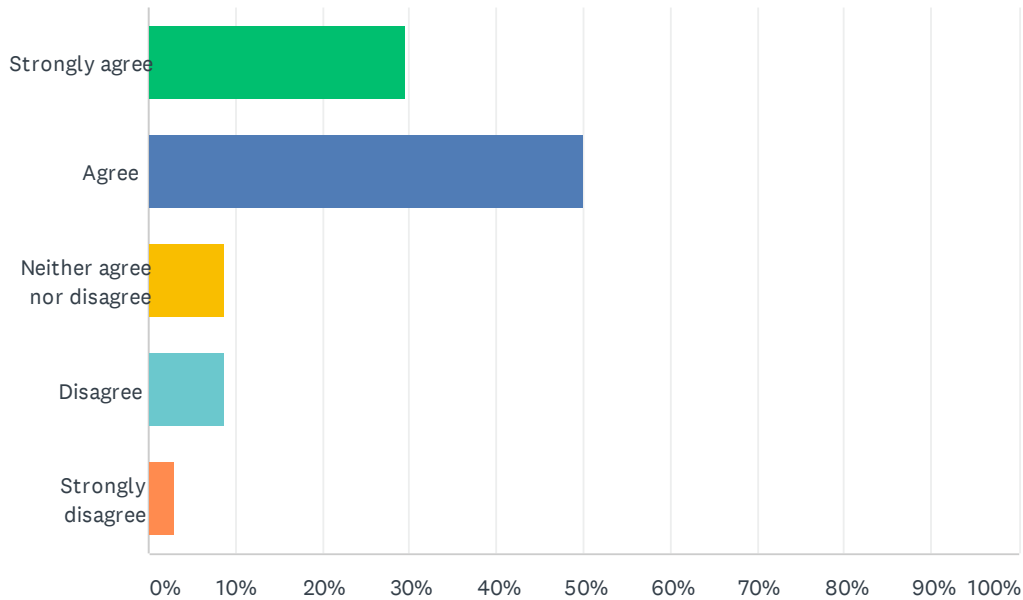

## Q2 My child's teachers and teaching assistants have communicated effectively with me during this 3rd national lockdown (since Monday 4th January)

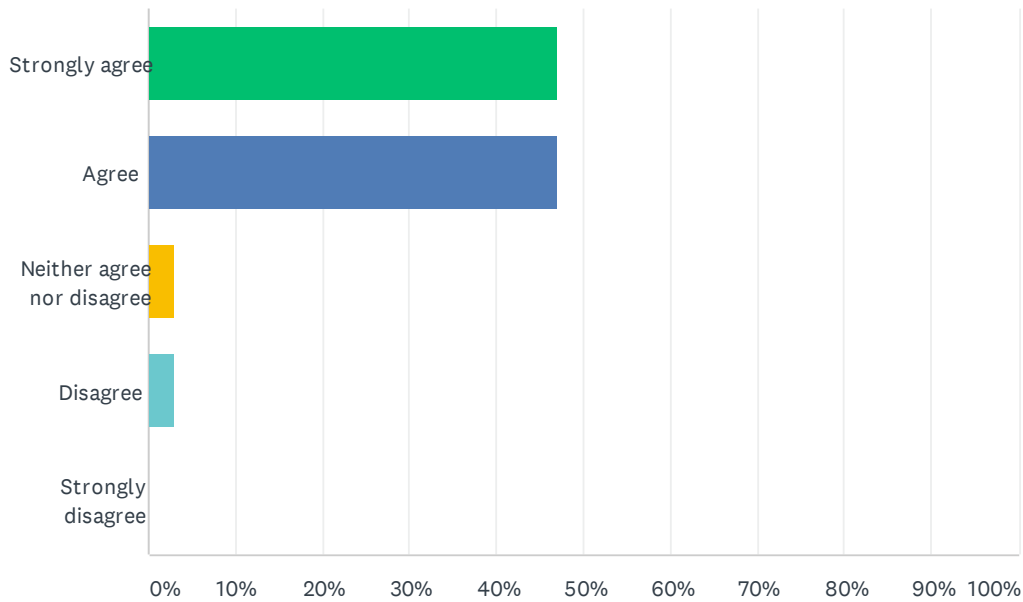

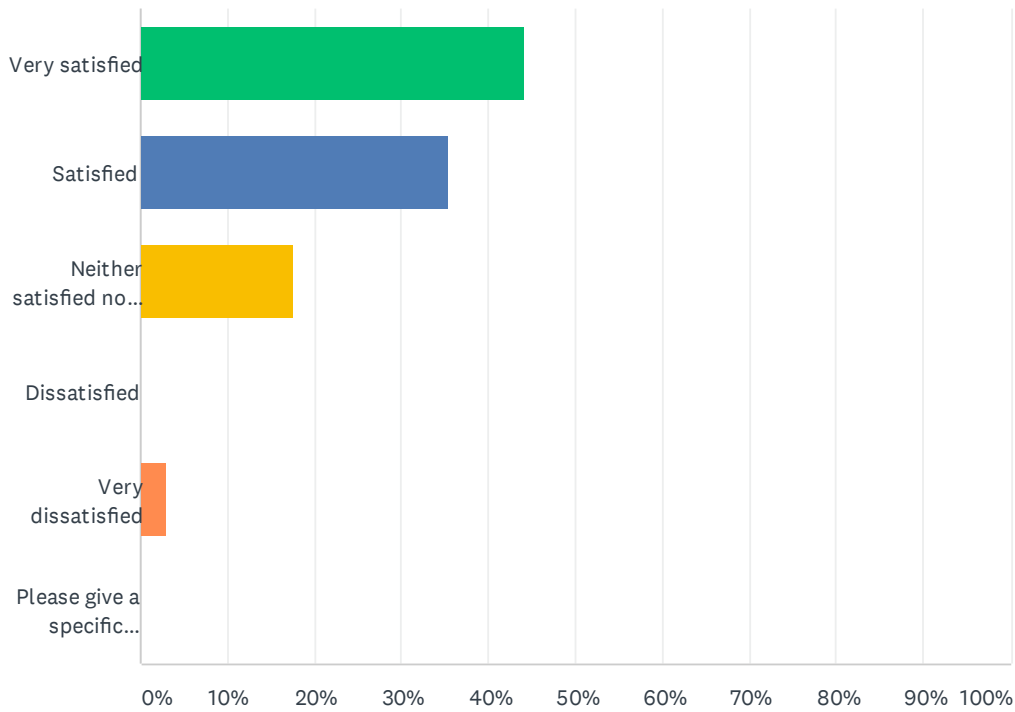

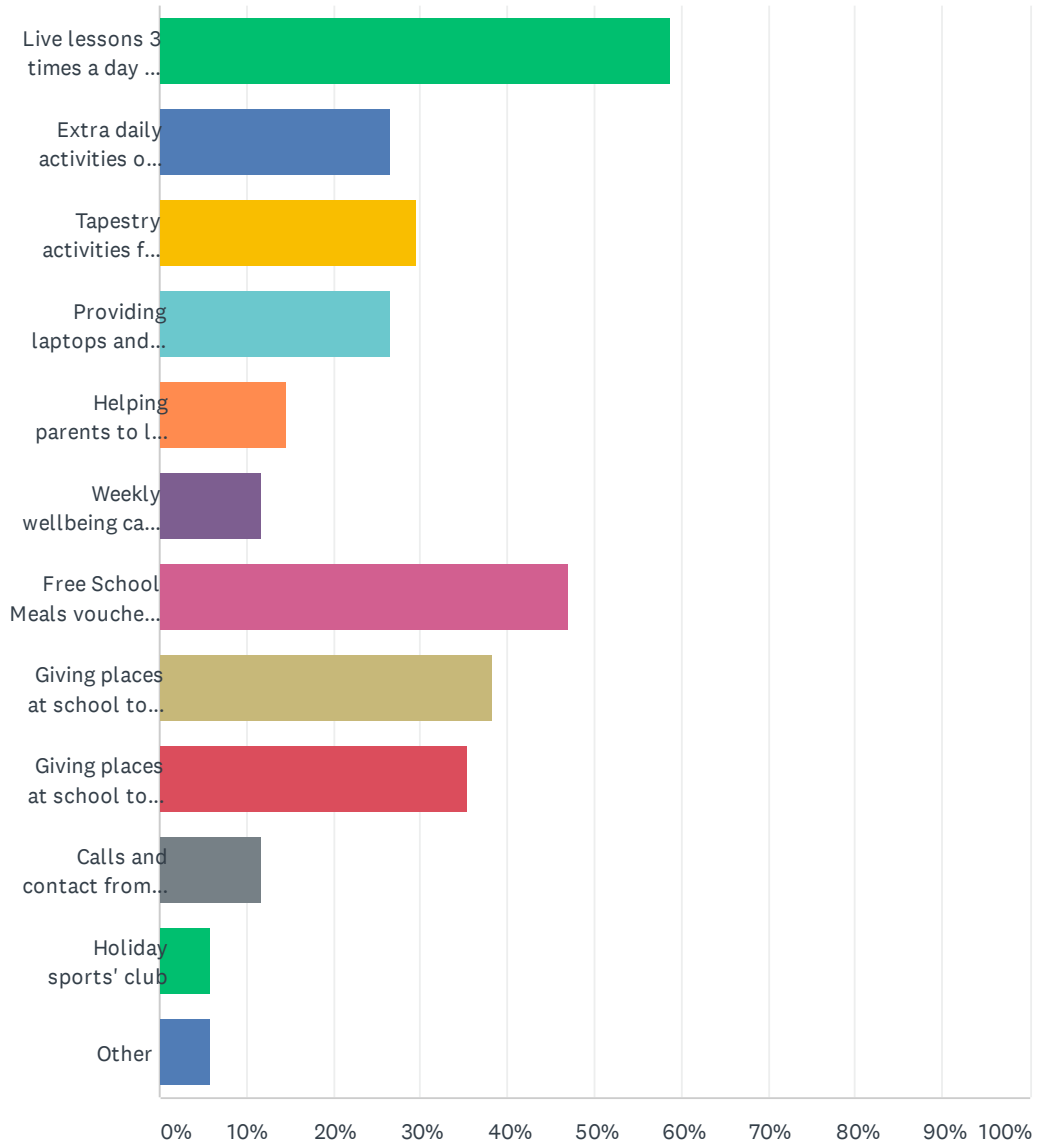
